Container for washing brushes (Holbein brush cleaner, Silicoil jar, or something similar)

Odorless Mineral Spirits

Portable palette (wood, wax paper or glass are all appropriate)

Paper towels

Notebook and a pen or pencil for taking notes

A palette knife (A long and narrow is perfect—like the 3" Loew Cornell or the Wyland Whale Tail that Dick Blick sells: <u>www.dickblick.com</u>)

One or 2 brushes (Recommended: Natural Bristle - Flat #2)

A wet canvas carrier to bring home your wet paintings

Oil Paints: "For the beginner to professional student, I recommend Windsor Newton Professional Grade, or similar. I mix a few other brands to get the pigments I desire. If you are going to buy Student Grade Paint such as 'Winton', please buy a quality tube of white by Winsor Newton or another professional grade brand. It's very difficult to get strong results with cheaper paints. Even if you're a beginner, I don't recommend Winton. If you're using it, consider upgrading."

"Below are the main colors I use on my palette. If you're a beginner and you're searching for what colors to start with, this is what I recommend. If you've been painting awhile and are comfortable with your own colors, then by all means use YOUR colors." For my plein air students this is what I recommend:
